TRAINING ON SAFE GRAIN STORAGE PRACTICES FOR RURAL WOMEN'S

India's grain production has steadily increased due to advance in technology in the form of hybrid seed, fertilizers and chemicals. But post harvest loss is constant which is 10% to 15%. Due to lack of storage facilities in rural areas farmers sold their produce in low price. Also the farm women's are not aware about the storage grains required for whole year so there is a need for aware the women for safe grain storage practices. Reducing post-harvest losses is considered as major steps towards food security. That's why KVK Washim under the Home Science department has organized one day training on "Safe Grain Storage practices" on dated 11 April 2019 at KVK campus. Dr. R. L. Kale, Sr. Scientist & Head KVK, Mr. R.S.Daware, SMS Plant protection, Miss. S.N. Watane, Home Scientist & Miss. Kamal Jadhav, SHG group leader were present on the dies. In the introductory remarks Miss. Watane briefed about the objective of the training. In technical session Dr. R. L. Kale explained the role of KVK for the upliftment of rural women's. He urged the participant to learn and understand the advance technology in farming system for their better life. He focused on the minimization of operational cost in agriculture which results in doubling farmer's income. Miss Shubhangi Watane, told that in India 20% of the population is undernourished, post harvest losses of 20 million tons annually is a substantial avoidable waste. Safe grain storage methods play a crucial role in preventing losses caused by weevils, beetles and rodents. To ensure safe and scientific storages carefully selection of storage site, storage structure and proper aeration of grains will be correct. She has demonstrated some equipment, edible powder which is used in grains for the control of weevils, beetles and rodents. Mr. R. S. Daware shows them the presentation on positive thinking & the story of Rabbit & Tortoise. He urged the participants to adopt women friendly technology in farming system and use this technology for the progress of SHG. 30 women participant were preset from different villages in Risod blocks. All KVK Staff took efforts for the success of these programme.

TRAINING ON ORGANIC FARMING & CROP PROTECTION

KVK Washim organized one day training for the farmers on organic farming & crop protection at KVK campus on 3rd April 2019. The theme behind the training was to make awareness about the organic farming practices & crop protection techniques for crop management. The programme was chaired by Dr. R.L. Kale Head & Sr. scientist KVK Washim. Sh. T.S.Deshmukh & Sh. R. S. Daware were the experts for the training. In the inaugural session Dr. Kale enlighten on organic farming model with integration of enterprises demonstrated on KVK farm. He stressed need to curtail the production cost by producing cheaper organic pesticides, composting in crop production on the farm and also advised for integrated farming module for farm income sustainability. Mr. T.S. Deshmukh told various farm waste composting methods to the farmers. Mr.. R.S. Daware advised farmers to use bio fertilizers, IPM methods in the organic crop production. The farmers visited organic unit and discussed about the IFS model in KVK. Sh. Ravi Ingole farmer from Chakawa village shared his views about training. At the end of training programme Sh. T.S. Deshmukh proposed vote of thanks for the programme.
