TREE PLANTATION CAMPAIGN AND KISAN GOSTHI HELD



Dr. R.L.Kale briefed about the need of timely vaccination

On the eve of launching National Animal Disease Control Programme for FMD and Brucellosis by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri.Narendraji Modi on 11 September, 2019 at Mathura and live webcast of the inaugural ceremony KVK Washim has organized workshop on Animal Health Management at KVK. Dr.R.L.Kale Senior Scientist cum Head KVK Washim presided over the function, while successful dairy entrepreneur Manoj Jadhav Shruti Dairy, Livestock Development Officer Mr.Jayshree Kendre were present as the guest of honor. KVK experts S.K.Deshmukh, R.S.Daware, N.B.Patil, T.S.Deshmukh, D.N.Ingole, Dr.D.L.Ramteke, Shubhangi Watane were also present on the dais. After live telecast of the launching programme, workshop at KVK was inaugurated speaking on the occasion Dr.R.L.Kale highlighted importance and need of timely vaccination for increasing animal productivity by which we can double farmer income through animal component. He further added initiatives like Azolla production, integrated farming system module, hydroponics and silage preparation undertaken by KVK. Dr.D.L.Ramteke guided farmers on need and importance of vaccination, disease management, measures for increasing animal productivity. He has also given basic tips for successful running of dairy, poultry, goatry enterprises. Mrs. Jayshree Kendre has given information about foot and mouth disease, vaccination schedule, symptoms of FMD and Brucellosis and requested farmers to do timely vaccination of cattle's against this diseases. **Cont. S.K.Deshmukh briefed about the plantation programme

The Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR) and Indian Farmers Fertilizer Co-op. (IFFCO) has organized Tree Plantation Campaign and Kisan Gosthi through KVKs across the country on 17 Sept. 2019 under the aegis of Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers welfare. On the eve of the campaign KVK Karda (Washim) has organized Kisan Gosthi for creating awareness and importance of tree plantation in the present scenario of climate change. Programme started with ICAR song, KVK experts S.K.Deshmukh, N.B.Patil, T.S.Deshmukh, Dr.D.L.Ramteke, P.V.Deshmukh and Prof. D.D.Masudkar were present on the dais. Speaking on the occasion S.K.Deshmukh emphasized on 33% forest cover is needed at present only 18-19% area is under tree plantation hence there is need of mass movement for eco friendly environment. KVK experts N.B.Patil guided farmers on fruits and vegetable cultivation and given advisory message on turmeric disease management, while Dr.D.L.Ramteke delivered lecture on animal vaccination, its benefits and importance of cattle shed cleaning. SMS Agronomy T.S.Deshmukh guided about soil health, water conservation, dry land horticulture and strategies for increasing rabi crop production technologies. D.D.Masudkar from Agriculture College, has given lecture on role of tree plantation in environment and assured that RAWES student will also distribute sapling for plantation to their adopted farmers.
